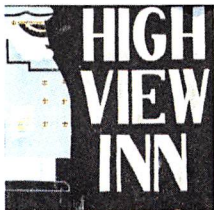

Facts about Methamphetamine...

 Young adults under 24 years old make up almost 60% of Meth users.

 Meth includes a number of harmful chemicals such as antifreeze, sulfuric and hydrochloric acid, lithium and ammonia.

 Meth causes significant tooth damage, hair loss, lesions on your skin, and nervous ticks

 Meth causes nausea, erratic and violent behavior, hallucinations, psychosis, convulsions, seizures, and death.

"I started using crystal meth when I was a senior in high school. Before my first semester of college was up, meth became such a big problem that I had to drop out. I looked like I had chicken pox from hours of staring at myself in the mirror and picking at myself. I spent all my time either doing meth or trying to get it."
