



Wisconsin DRE Commitment Pledge

This Commitment Pledge was established by the Wisconsin DRE Oversight Committee and the DRE State Coordinator in accordance with IACP standards.

As a Drug Recognition Expert there are program expectations you need to be aware of prior to your commitment to the training. As a DRE you will be required to:

- Successfully complete the DRE Pre-School, DRE School, and Field Certifications, including the correct identification of 4 of the 7 drug categories.
- Complete and maintain your rolling log and Curriculum Vitae (resume).
- Attend regularly scheduled DRE in-service trainings (a minimum of eight hours annually). In lieu of attending an in-service training, a DRE may attend specialized drug-related training approved *in advance* by the State Coordinator.
- Send copies of updated rolling log and new evaluations to Regional Coordinator every six months (end of June and December).
- Send updated Curriculum Vitae (resume) to Regional Coordinator (annually).
- Maintain the integrity of the program, and keep current on drug trends and drug-related information.
- Update, as necessary, and after each evaluation, entries on the DRE website: sobrietytesting.org.
- Perform a minimum of four (4) acceptable evaluations since the date of last certification, all of which shall be reviewed and approved by a certified DRE instructor, one (1) of which shall be witnessed by a certified DRE instructor. These evaluations may be performed on subjects suspected of drug and/or alcohol impairment or during classroom simulations.
- Maintain and replace when necessary all DRE issued equipment to good working order.
- Be willing to respond when available and as needed to perform the duties and functions as a DRE when requested by other officers to include but not limited to officers from other agencies within the county of my jurisdiction or agency.

DRE Candidate Agreement

I, _____, understand the expectations and requirements of the Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) program. I agree to maintain my Curriculum Vitae (resume) as required, and faithfully maintain my rolling log and stay current with my entries into the DRE website. I understand that I am also required to maintain copies of my evaluations, and forward copies of these as well as other required documents to my Regional Coordinator. I agree to submit these documents on a timely basis, and maintain my training and expertise by attending trainings. I understand that I am required to attend regular in-service trainings to maintain my certifications. I agree to maintain my expertise in recognizing drug-impaired persons, and to keep current on drug trends. I understand that my certification will expire or be non-renewed if I fail to perform the minimum number of acceptable evaluations set forth by IACP standards within any given certification period, one of which must be witnessed by a DRE instructor. I will maintain my DRE equipment and keep it at my disposal to respond when requested and available to assist other officers. This I pledge.
